The Museum of Native American History was established in downtown Bentonville in 2006 as the Museum of Native American Artifacts. The collection quickly outgrew the space, and MONAH opened its current doors in June 2008. A registered member of the Cherokee Nation, David Bogle, born and raised in Bentonville, founded the museum that houses over 10,000 of the finest Native American artifacts. The museum features Bogle's private collection and several collections donated and on loan to the museum for display.
